Welcome and thank you for becoming a member of Kununurra Neighbourhood House.

Kununurra Neighbourhood House (KNH) is a not for profit organisation. We have been operating within Kununurra since 1979. KNH is dedicated to local community enrichment, drawing upon strategies that encourage self-help which results in support for individuals and families with children aged between 0-5 years. KNH is a universal outfit, offering a range of unique and essential services including a regular weekly timetable of programs, information and referrals, equipment hire, onsite crèche facilities, emergency relief (food hamper) and a low cost second hand clothing and small household goods outlet. We welcome all new members and hope your experience with Kununurra Neighbourhood House is both positive and rewarding.

The Responsibilities of members:

- Pay an annual membership subscription of \$30.00 (Inc. GST) per calendar year. Payment can be made by cash, cheque or **EFT to Kununurra Neighbourhood House BSB: 086-787 ACC: 821582319 (Please use your first initial and surname as reference).**
- Introduce and promote the Kununurra Neighbourhood House to friends, family and acquaintances.
- Obey the rules as found in the Constitution, and the Policies and Procedures of the Association. (Please ask for a copy when submitting your application)
- Ensure you sign in for programs and pay required sessions fees when appropriate.

The Privileges of Members:

- Eligibility to become part of the KNH Management Committee and/or vote at the Annual General Meeting (held in October)
- Borrow from the KNH Resources Library
- Enjoy KNH tea and coffee facilities free of charge
- Receive the KNH Newsletter
- Be the first to know what's new at KNH via email updates
- Benefit from our members only services and giveaways
- Reduced rate on venue hire (Minimum of \$20 per hour) – *KNH is great for kid's birthday parties!*
- Free novelty cake tin hire (huge selection of tins), a bond of \$20 is returned when tins are.
- Purchase Group Session Card, pay for 10 sessions and get 11th session free.

Volunteer Opportunities:

- Become more involved and join the KNH Volunteer Management Committee.
- Clothing Recyclers manage and control stock in the Op shop.
- Help out at community events including the annual Teddy Bears Picnic.
- Share your knowledge and skills - Specialist guest speakers/Micro business promotion presenting at programs/workshops. Handyman and gardening services all welcomed.

Onsite Crèche:

Crèche is available for children aged from 7 months (& sitting independently) to 5 years. When utilizing the KNH onsite crèche facilities please ensure that you present to KNH crèche staff to discuss individual needs, and sign your child into each session attended. Due to licensing, parents/carers must remain on the KNH premises at all times. Children may not attend consecutive crèche sessions without a 1 hour break. Please ensure that you child is wearing appropriate sun protection and has a hat and water bottle. Please clearly label all your child's belongings.

KNH is an 'Allergy Aware' centre; for the safety of others **please avoid bringing nut products into KNH.** If your child is being cared for in our crèche while you are attending a workshop/group, please provide a piece of fruit which our staff will cut up to share at morning tea time. Personal lunch boxes and snacks are only to be made available to your child under your supervision.
